The Heroes of Lynbrook initiative discovers and celebrates individuals who have contributed to the community in a variety of ways both through formal volunteer opportunities and informal actions that significantly and positively impact the community and its members. It could be someone you know who volunteers delivering Meals on Wheels or it could be that person who checks in on an elderly neighbour on a regular basis. Maybe you know someone who has scored for the cricket club every week during the season, or someone who does the shopping for a neighbour who cannot get out easily.

We want to hear about the ordinary people in our community who make a positive impact. If you know someone – why not nominate them as a Hero of Lynbrook.

Nomination Information

- » Nominations open 9.00 am on Wednesday 13 May 2020.
- » Nominations close 5.00 pm on Friday 12 June 2020.
- » Nomination forms should include all relevant information. Nominations will be assessed only on the information provided in the nomination form. No additional information will be considered.
- » All nominations remain the property of the City of Casey.

Eligibility and Criteria

- » Nominees must live in Lynbrook/Lyndhurst or their contributions must have a positive impact on the lives of Lynbrook/Lyndhurst residents.
- » To discover and celebrate community role models whose volunteering activities or personal acts of kindness create positive benefits for others in one or more of the following ways:
 - » Nurturing a sense of belonging and inclusion.
 - » Helping in times of community crisis.
 - » Building community resilience.
 - » Promoting positive health and wellbeing.
 - » Advocates for the community.
- » A maximum of three individual nominees per group/organisation may be submitted.
- » All nominees over the age of 18 years may be required to sign a Statutory Declaration stating that they do not have a criminal record, convictions and/or outstanding or pending charges. Or provide a character reference stating past indiscretions are no longer valid.

Ineligibility – The following will not be considered

- » Self-nominations.
- » Nominations for current or past City of Casey staff (within five years since employment ceased).
- » Nominations for current or past City of Casey Councillors (within five years since serving as a Councillor).
- » Incomplete nomination forms.
- » Nomination forms not submitted via the online system.
- » Nominations received after the closing date of **5.00 pm on Friday 12 June 2020**.
