THE DO'S AND DONT'S	THE PANELS' TIPS
<p>Do share how your nominee has made a positive impact to the lives of those in Casey.</p> <p>Don't give one sentence answers.</p> <p>Do include examples and stories.</p> <p>Don't forget to talk about the impact this has on the community.</p> <p>Do be honest and transparent.</p> <p>Don't worry about being biased - you should be proud to submit this individual or group for nomination.</p> <p>Do contact a council officer if you need assistance writing your nomination.</p> <p>Don't be afraid to reach out to others who know the nominee to ask for more information and stories.</p>	<p>Stay within the word count but include as much detail as possible.</p> <p>Include examples of what your nominee or group has done that makes them outstanding in the Casey community.</p> <p>Speak with other people who might be able to offer support or advice on what else you could include in the nomination.</p> <p>Avoid generalities (such as 'they are a great community member') give clear examples of why and how they are great community members.</p>
