

Botanic Ridge Boulevard Reserve Playground

The Botanic Ridge Park Playground upgrade expands the existing infrastructure to provide several new play opportunities as well as new tree plantings to provide additional shade. The existing arbour/shade structure and social space located at the junction of the two existing paths is retained with minor pavement repairs undertaken to fix the existing paving. This includes removal of the existing concrete retaining wall which will be replaced by a sloping garden area with lower rock edging. The existing rope play structure or space net will be retained, with additional play elements being added to new terraces located along the existing northern path. Located at the top level of the play space is a new double swing and nest swing, with views down the slope. A senior combination unit featuring two slides, rock wall, rope wall and climbing wall will be set on the lower section. A lower level provides a junior unit and a mound slide, which links down to the existing rope play. Kids can move between the top and bottom of the mound slide using the rubberised steps on each side of the slide. Additional shade will be provided by new tree plantings. Sloped, planted garden beds in combination with rock work stabilise the areas between the play terraces. Accessible paths enable visitors of all abilities to access the key play elements.
