

Avebury Drive Playground

The concept for Avebury Drive Playground proposes new play spaces, which complement the established woodland and existing recreation opportunities within the reserve. A new entry path will draw visitors through the existing trees via the car park, to the existing shelter and play space. Path connections to the existing toilets, basketball half-court and Timbarra Community Centre will be retained. Three play units are proposed for the play space to cater for users of different ages and physical abilities. The junior unit allows for imaginative play with fireman's pole, shop counter and climbing wall. The senior unit will feature spiral slide, rope wall and climbing ladder. The mid-sized unit offers additional play elements for children of all ages with a curved slide, steps, climbing walls and a puzzle panel. Scattered around the three play units are more play opportunities. The new swings and flying saucer provide the opportunity for movement and motion.
